Wind with squalls 3 Pm Spoke the morning light
Apt put letters on board our mail in tuckahoe
this part Wind W.N.W. had in S.W. middle part later 5 Am
the Captain put his letters on board of the morning light
this part in playd in Coopering oil creeping from
the N.W. moor of it and lashed the oil to bed.

Wednesday Feb 12th Commences with a gail from the
1 Pm 3 Pm lost rap the main top sail and raft
the fore sail blowing having 6 kysted the boats two
the davy heads middle and later part 3 m over ated 7 Pm
began on the oil this part Wind lapping

Thursday Feb 13th Commences with the wind light and
baffling with a heavy swell on with rain 4 Pm the
oil all Coopered and piled up 6 Pm this part rain
7 lit up in the S.W. Wind light from the E.S.E.
middle and later part moderate this part in playd in show-
ing down Lat Long

Friday Feb 14th Commences with light airs from the S.W.
in playd in showing down 6 Pm all down 7 Spoke the
Ship John Cogswell middle part Wind light later part
Wind from the North made all sail in playd in bechin-
g out the Aflor hole for meat Lat 43 50 Long

Saturday Feb 15th Commences with fresh breezes from the
W.N.W. 3 Pm took in the fore top sail 5 Sat it more
moderate 7 Pm strong breezes middle part Wind W.N.W.
later part Wind from the S.W. light all sail out
Lat 43 50 Long 75 15

Sunday Feb 16th Commences with light airs and
comes in playd in splicing the big look rope
Sundown Sat the fore top gallant sail and main sail
splicing 5 the west end of guano having 14 miles of
Wind W.N.W. light airs middle part light breezes baffling hav-
ing of shore later part light airs and comes the land
20 miles of Lat 43 47 Long 75 35 W.

Monday Feb 17th Commences with light airs from the E.S.E.
the Captain down for a Sord fish but gave him up and
came on board 2 Pm light breezes from the Sutherland
ing in Sundown wore Ship of Shore and took in sail the land
15 miles of middle part Wind South later part 5 Pm made
sail heding in Wind South fine weather Lat 43 53 Long 75 10

Tuesday Feb 18th Commences with fresh breezes from the
South fine weather but no Whales Sundown took in sail
heding of Shore the land 18 miles of middle part
Wind light from the South later part 5 Pm made all
sail this part in playd in mending the fore sail Lat 43 55 Long 75 20

Wednesday Feb 19th Commences with light breezes from
the S.E. Steering 1 Pm W in playd in mending the fore
sail 4 Pm all beat this part Steering 1 Pm by 1
5 Pm were round and stood by the wind heding in
Sundown took in sail middle and later part Wind S.E.
fresh breezes hole top sail on Lat 43 40 Long 75 44 W.

Thursday Feb 20th Commences with fresh breezes from the
South heding in this part wore new main braces Sundown
Wore Ship of Shore with the main top sail a back and bearing
1 Pm 12 miles of middle and later part light breezes
from the Sutherland all sail out Lat 43 43 Long 75 22 W.

Friday Feb 21th Commences with light breezes from the
Sutherland all sail out this part Saw nothing Sundown
took in sail with the head yards a back middle part
light breezes from the North later part fine weather
Wind from the North in playd in beeching the chains
out Side Lat 43 43 Long 75 14

Saturday Feb 22th Commences with fresh breezes 4 Pm
Wind S.W. light with fog Sundown took in sail
middle part light airs and comes later part
Wind warling with showers of rain like thunder
Showers mid part Saw a Sapher Saturn Lat 43 41
Long 75 34
