Wednesday Mar 19th Commences with fresh breezes from
the N N W heding N N W 1 P m saw a bark heding in
Shore 3 P m wore ship heding N by E 4 P m Wind
hauled two the S E double reef the top sails and sterd
N N E thick and raining middle part blowing fresh from the
S E Steering N N E later part Steering N N E 9 A m saw the
Land Lat 35 23 Long 74 25

Thursday Mar 20th Commences with fresh breezes from the
S S E Steering E N E by the wind half past 4 wore ship of
Shore from mocha middle part heding off and on later
part half past 10 A m the Captin went in with two boats
trading for wood and potatoes Lat Long

Friday Mar 21st Commences with light breezes from
the S E half past 3 boats came off with wood and
potatoes dark all of 1 cove of wood and 63 bbls of potatoes
this part Steering S E by E middle part Wind hauled two
the S E A m heap of N W by S this part in ployd
in Stowing wood in the after hole Lat 37 52 Long 74 35

Saturday Mar 22nd Commences with Strong breezes from the
South Steering N W by N in ployd in Splitting wood
And Stowing it in the after hole 6 P m Steering N W
middle part Strong breezes Steering for the water water rap
later part Steering by the wind here S W this part
in ployd in Washing Ship under double reef top Sails

Sunday Mar 23rd Commences with Strong breezes from the
S S E in ployd in washing Ship in side 4 P m all done
this part saw two Sail middle and later part
Strong winds from the South 10 wore ship this part
heding E under double reef top Sails Lat 37 Long 75 30

Monday Mar 24th Commences with Strong winds from the
heding E this part saw two Sail Steering N N E this part
saw Sulpher botoms Sun down blowing fresh middle part took in
the fore top Sail 5 P m set it 1 took it in blowing fresh
heding E by S Lat 37 3 Long 74 35

Tuesday Mar 25th Commences with Strong breezes from the
South 1 P m set the fore top Sail and sterd E by N
5 P m saw 1 t mares E it bore S E 1 point per compass
this part running under short Sail middle part Wind light
later part saw the paps Wind light with fog
this part got the anchors of the bore Lat 36 40 Long

Wednesday Mar 26th Commences with light breezes from
the S 3 P m rounded quinquina 6 P m let go the
starboard anchor under capo horn and Shuck out 45
fathoms of Chain and paid the Sails middle part
later part in ployd in Washing Ship out Side

Thursday Mar 27th Commences with fine weather in ployd
in taking out the fore hole for Stowing water
middle part later part in ployd in painting
Ship out Side and taking water from the water
boat 1 P m 10 A m all the water in

Friday Mar 28th in ployd in painting out Side and
Stowing water 5 P m the starboard Side all done and
the Starboard Side to the west middle part later
in ployd in blacking the benches the Deckent boat
Amid sent the 25 bbls of Right Whale oil on Shore

Saturday Mar 29th this part took flower and meat
on board and Sung up for liberty cart lot a part
of the crew take a run on Shore till 11 o'clock
middle part later part this part
sent the Starboard Watch on liberty
