Friday Apr 4th Commences with light breezes from the South
in play in fitting a piece on the keel 1 P.M. let
the officers and boat Stairs go in for a run middle part
later part 8 A.M. sent the Spanker gaft down and put
a dogge in the Shiv hole

part 9 A.M. the men came off that he shipped for a year
this part wind light from the North

Thursday Apr 10th Commences with the wind from the South
this part clearing 11 A.M. by 11 P.M. E & this part saw
three sail run in down the coast dark wore ship of shore
and took in Sail middle part later thick fog 9 A.M.
let up this part fitting the fore top gallant brace blocks
Sat 35 2 Long
