W. or S.W. in play in Ship's duty till sail out
middle part the spanker gaff came down the stavel
broke 7 A.M. saw two sperm whales going S by E
saw them were risen then set in fog but kept run
of them in the fog for 3 risens W. towards for them
lit up at about Noon Starboard boat struck



Sunday Ap 13 Commences with the wind from the W. or
the W. or S.W. and the Starboard boat have her line
and bent on look mine and half of her rig tab
the whale run to leeward the west boat went on
and struck and got stove and cut of a look
my line then the whale run to windward hard
all of the time got 3 or 4 risens in him then
he mild of and run to leeward a boat fore
clock got blood from him then he mock in both
Starboard Struck and looked to keep her free
Sun down got him to the Ship middle part in play
in breaking out later part 7 A.M. saw whales
3 points forward the weather clear 1 toward 3 boats for

Between the yellow water up and Swan for hands.

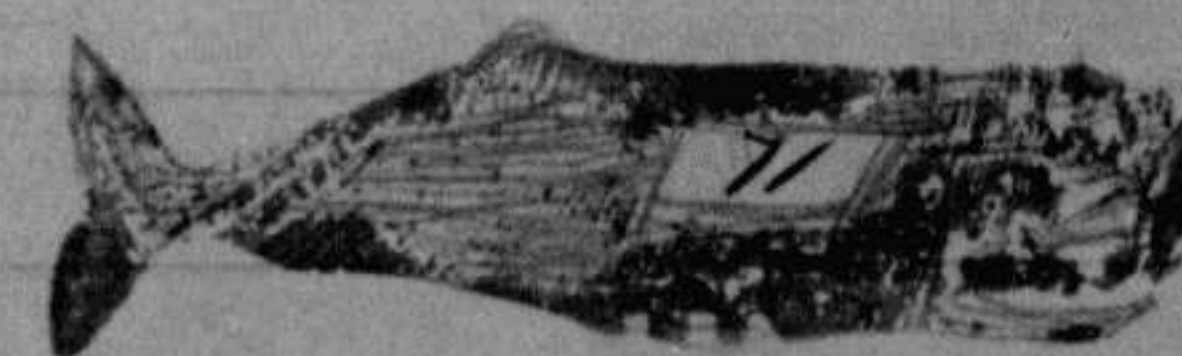
Wednesday Ap 16th Commences with the wind from the S. E.

Starboard boat and put the over board boat out 7 A.M.
saw sperm whales of the 11 bow is going to windward
part made a tack and got to windward of them
fresh breezes from the wind S. E. Lat 35 4 Long 16 27

the S. E. 11 boats in per. Sute of whales
8 P.M. the Starboard boat
Struck the West and bow boat
