Wednesday June 18th Commences with fresh breezes heading to the South in play on the main riggen Sundown wore ship to the S^W middle and later part 1 A.M. saw a bark a whaling of the 10th bore. We got over a nap to see them strike the west went to windward 5 sail in site. We made all sail but the fore top gallent sail and kept them in site.

Thursday June 19th Commences with strong breezes working up for the whales took out back 8 P.M. they went out of site on the weather beam Sundown backed ship to the S^W split the main top gallent sail and sent it down to repair middle part fresh breezes heading to the S^W wore ship to the South. This part in play in repairing the main top gallent sail put on three cloth of raven duck.

Friday June 20th Commences with strong breezes heading to the South. Saw a bark a Shoon this part in play on the main top gallent sail 5 P.M. sent it and wore ship to the S^W wind it to middle and later part this part in play in turning in the main top mast back stays and survived them.

Saturday June 21st Commences with the wind S^W steering of in play in turning in riggen 5 P.M. spoke the bark Edwards of New Bedford middle and later part 7 A.M. spoke the answer and got over colors. This part in play in making the oil

Sunday June 22nd Commences with fresh breezes steering of S^W saw 2 sail middle and later part this part saw 5 sail all running of wind light

Monday June 23rd Commences with light breezes from the S^W steering of S^W 11 P.M. saw 7 sail with all sail out middle and later part fresh breezes 11 A.M. wind light steering of saw 3 sail

Tuesday June 24th Commences with light airs from the S^W steering of S^W by S Sundown Steered S^W by W middle and later part this part steering of in play in turning up the main riggen and surviving it on the weather side. This part saw 2 sail

Wednesday June 25th Commences with fresh breezes steering of in play on the main riggen 3 P.M. spoke the bark Shuttles of New Bedford middle part under short sail middle and later fresh breezes this part in play on the main riggen saw 2 sail

Lat 19 42 Long 92 47

5 m. Play on the riggen

Thursday June 26th Commences with fresh breezes this part heading to the North in play on the riggen and getting out Sundown took in the light sails middle and later part light airs and carries this part in play on the main riggen.

Friday June 27th Commences with light airs in play on the main riggen Sundown took in the light sails heading to the East wind S^W middle and later part this part 9 A.M. set in with strong trinds took in the light sails and double reef the top sails this part 11 work on the main riggen saw a bark a whaling

Lat 19 36 Long 91 25

Saturday June 28th Commences with strong breezes in play on the main riggen Sundown saw 3 sail this part took in the gill and hauled down the head of the spanker middle and later part blowing from the S^W under double top sails this part saw 3 sail

Lat 19 37 Long 91 02

Sunday June 29th Commences with strong trinds. Spoke a bark past us heading to the S^W this part saw a new moon middle and later part 8 A.M. more moderate made sail this part saw 3 sail heading to the S^W with fine with a good breeze
