Thursday Oct 2nd Commences with fresh traids hiding
N.E. by 6. in play in breaking out for mist
thick over east with middle part later part fresh
traids hiding N.E. all come up 8 by N.E. this part
all sail out saw fm backs Lat 13 32 Long 77 12 11

Friday Oct 3rd Commences with fresh traids hiding E
and E by S 2 Pm saw the land 43 miles off this part
saw fm backs sundown took in the light sails
middle and later part 3 A.m. tacked Ship to the East
day light saw the Shipping at anchor to the Chinchas Islands
stood in till 10 A.m. were round of shore the Capt. went
in with a boat to by potatoes

Saturday Oct 4th Commences with light traids lying off
and on 4 Pm the Capt. in came of but could not
by any potatoes they were a boat 7 rollers for bbls this part
hiding of shore S by W to SW dark took in the light sails
middle part hiding of and on later part 3 A.m. the
Capt. went in to send letters and bought ~~XXXX~~
A boat 10 bbls of potatoes came of at noon
Lat 12 40 Long 76 37

Sunday Oct 5th Commences with fresh traids standing off shore
all sail out hiding S.W. by W middle part fresh traids
bating up the east later part the same fresh traids
thick over east with Lat Long

Working up the coast from the Chincas Islands
Monday Oct 6th Commences with fresh traids hiding S by W
5 Pm saw black fish this part thick and over east
with middle part and later fresh traids all sail out
hiding S by W this part saw nothing Lat 15 11 Long 77 53

Tuesday Oct 7th Commences with fresh traids hiding S by W
this part saw killers 6 Pm took in the main top gallant
sail middle and later part strong traids hiding South
this part saw hump backs Lat 17 3 Long 78 53

Wednesday Oct 8th Commences with strong traids
hiding to the South light sails in fore top sail
dark raft this part saw nothing middle and later part
strong traids 5 A.m. took in the S by W took in the
main sail blowing past Lat 18 35 Long 79 51

Thursday Oct 9th Commences with strong traids
hiding South this part saw nothing under double reef
top sails middle and later part strong traids under
double reef top sails thick over east with Lat Long

Friday Oct 10th Commences with strong traids hiding
S by W under double reef top sails 11 Pm saw porpoises
middle and later part strong traids hiding South
Lat 21 10 Long 80 02

Saturday Oct 11th Commences with strong traids hiding
South by W thick over east this part saw porpoises
middle and later part strong traids hiding to the South
under double reef top sails over east Lat 22 42 Long 82 55

Sunday Oct 12th Commences with strong traids hiding
S by E under double reef top sails this part saw nothing
middle and later part strong traids hiding S by E
with more clear over head this part saw nothing
Lat 24 10 Long 83 42
