South in play in buying black fish later 3 Pm
all there saw a ship ranging of middle and later part
Strong breezes from the South under double reef top
sails saw a bark ranging of the Leeward
with a fore sail out Got Long

Thursday Jan 28 Commences with Strong breezes

from the South under double reef top sails 1 Pm
Saw the Merlon had got two large whales and
crying by voices had heading to the WSW 4 Pm
with clear but blowing fresh 3 Pm took in the
gib and spanker middle and later part Strong breezes
from the South under double reef top sails Got 4323 Long

Friday Jan 29 Commences with Strong breezes
from the South under double reef top sails 6 Pm saw
black fish this part blowing Strong middle and later

Saturday Jan 30 Commences with Strong breezes
from the SSE ship under double reef top sails head-
ing in shore 2 Pm wore ship of shore middle and
later part foggy Wind SSE Got Long

Sunday Jan 31 Commences with thick fog heading N. E.
1 Pm took in the light sails 2 Pm saw the island
of the Leeward with all sail out half past 2 lit up
Saw two or 3 boats for whales ahead
sail and ran of half past 3 toward
3 boats for a pod harbor boat went in
but the whale showed black flukes and she came did not go
in good it came out the next risen the boat went
in and struck and got him this part in play inventing
later part 5 A m all in it started the work
