Wednesday Apr 8th Commences with fresh breezes from the S.E.
in ployd in mending the fore top sail this part
set the main sail 1 P.M. more moderate over east
with a haze heading to the S.E. middle and later part
light breezes this part in ployd in scraping ship out
side and digging out the old paint of the piggy head
Lat 34 15 Long 77 1/2

Thursday Apr 9th Commences with light airs from the S.E.
this part in ployd in mending the fore top sail 3 P.M.
sent it and stored the main in the sail pen 5 P.M.
saw a sail on the Wether quarter this part saw sun fish
and grampis middle and later part light breezes from the
S.E. in ployd in scraping the hull works on the S.E. side
and scrubbing them Lat 34 24 Long 76 31

Friday Apr 10th Commences with light breezes in ployd
in scraping and scrubbing middle and later part came
in ployd in scraping out side the cabin painting
the cabin and 4 in the cow boat cleaning the grass of
the benches in both sides Lat 34 46 Long 76 37 1/2
