

Bark *Yarak* of *Attapousett*
Thurs June commences with light breeze and
the 11th fine weather from *S* steering *E by S*
all sail out one sail in sight
Middle part the same

15
Latter part the same at 8 o'clock saw
Spum whale and lowered the quarter
boats the Capt struck and got him
at 12 o'clock took him alongside
at Lat 30 17 N Long about 56

Fri June commences with fine weather
the 12th employed in getting ready and cutting
took in the jib and lashed down
Middle part the same at daylight
hooked on and went to cutting
Latter part the same

Sat June commences with fresh breeze from *W*
the 13th finished cutting and hauling the ease
Middle part the same employed in clearing
up the deck at 2 o'clock started the work
Latter part light from *E*

Sun June commences with light breeze and fine
the 14th weather from *E* employed in boiling
Middle part the same
Latter part the same

Mon June commences with fresh breeze from *W by W*
the 15th saw two Humpbacks employed in boiling
Middle part heavy squalls and rain rolled
down the work clean up the fore topsail
Latter part strong breeze and roused
employed in boiling and breaking
out the fore hole for cask
at Lat 33 17 N

Tues June commences with strong breeze from *W by W*
the 16th heading *S* employed in boiling and steering
down in the main hole at 6 finished boiling
Middle part the same set boat crew watches
at daylight called all hands and back out the hole
Latter part the same employed in steering down
in the main hole and boiling fatcask

Wed June commences with strong breeze and roused
the 17th from *W* heading *S by W* employed in steering
down started one cask of bread and one of
sails at 6 o'clock the Capt lowered for blackfish
but without success
Middle part the same from *W*
Latter part the same steering *E by S* under
double reef topsails employed in steering down
and clearing up deck at 12 o'clock

Thurs June commences with fresh gale from *S by W*
the 18th heading *S by W* under double reef topsails
employed in steering away and clearing up
Middle part the same
Latter part much the same set jib and mainsail
histing *S by W by W* at 12 o'clock took in jib and
mainsail and wore ship to the *SE*
at Lat 34 52 N

Fri June commences with strong breeze and very
the 19th roused from *S by W* heading *S by E* double reef topsails
Middle part moderate steering *E by S*
all sail out
Latter part strong breeze from *W by W*
the Capt still took care of duty
