

Back Inland of Mattapoisett  
Sat June the 20<sup>th</sup> Commences with storm breeze and smoky atmosphere from W. S. W. steering E by N all sail out  
Middle part light steering E. S. E.  
Latter part strong  
at Lat 36.55 N

Sun June the 21<sup>st</sup> Commences with moderate breeze and smoky atmosphere from W. steering E by N all drawing sail out  
Middle part strong  
Latter part wind hauling to the N and sailing  
at Lat 38.03 N

Mon June the 22<sup>nd</sup> Commences with light breeze with thick and rainy weather from S all sail out steering E by N saw Humphbacks  
Middle part calm and rainy  
Latter part light air from E heading S. E. by the wind one sail in sight  
at Lat 38.12 N

Tues June the 23<sup>rd</sup> Commences with light air from E heading S. E. by the wind all sail out three sail in sight heading to the N. E. by the wind  
Middle part light air from E heading S. E.  
Latter part the same from S. E. heading E. S. E. all sail out five sail in sight steering E. S. E.  
at Lat 38.11 N

Wed June the 24<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh breeze from N. E. and veering to the E heading S. E. all sail out five sail in sight steering E. S. E.  
Middle part the same from S. E. to S heading by the wind to the eastward  
Latter part the same employed in setting up the main topmast back stays and lacing the lanyards on sail in sight  
at Lat 39.30 N

Thurs June the 25<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh breeze from S. E. heading E by the wind all sail out saw Humphbacks at breacking to windward  
Middle part light from S. W. steering S. E. at 3.40 A.M. made the Island of Flores bearing S. E. by E 2 miles distance 25 miles fore sail in sight steering E  
Latter part the same all hands employed in heaving out and pumping of oil and getting it ready to land at Bayal  
Land Flores

Fri June the 26<sup>th</sup> Commences with light breeze from S. W. steering S. E. all sail out employed in heaving out oil two sail in sight to windward  
Middle the same at 4 A.M. made Bayal bearing S. E. by E distance 35 miles  
Latter part the same  
the Cook and Jim Sick and of duty  
Land Bayal

Sat June the 27<sup>th</sup> Commences with light breeze and fine weather from N. W. at 1 P.M. of Bayal the Capt took a boat and went on shore at 6 returned  
Middle part the same of and on  
Latter part the same at 1 A.M. the lighter came of and took one oil cask and 2 blks  
employed in lying up and on
