Mon July Commences with fresh breeze and squally
the 6th from SSW heading W by the wind
Middle part light from SSW steering
W by N all sail out
Latter part the same from SSW employed
in breaking out for Slaps and bread
back fire and black sick and of duty

Tues July Commences with light air and calm
the 7th from SSW steering W by N all sail out
the second mate lowered to practice his crew
Middle part the same
Latter part light breeze from S steering
W by N all sail out lowered for Killers but
did not get fast at 10 o'clock heaving up
A number of sail in sight
Lat 39 00 N
Long 39 00 W

Wed July Commences with strong breeze and
the 8th squally from SSW steering by the wind
W by N under single reef topsails
Middle part the same
Latter part much the same
Lat 38 09 N Long 38 40 W

Thurs July Commences with strong breeze and
the 9th smoky atmosphere from W heading S by W
all sail out one sail in sight
Middle part the same
Latter much the same
Lat 38 09 N Long 38 20 W

Fri July Commences with strong breeze and thick
the 10th heavy weather from SSW heading W by N
Middle part sailing at 9 o'clock cleared up wind
hauled out W
Latter part fresh breeze and smoky
one sail in sight
Lat 38 05 N
Long 38 05 W
Cook black sea and fire shot of duty

Sat July Commences with fresh breeze and hazy from
the 11th W heading N at 3 o'clock thick and raining
Middle part the same at 9 cleared up the
wind N by E at 4 o'clock kept of NW
Latter part strong breeze steering W by S
under double reef topsails three sail in sight
at Lat 38 25 N Long 38 05 W

Sun July Commences with strong breeze from
the 12th N steering W by S took in jib and main sail
at 4 blowing on hove to under close reef
main topsail heading N by W
Middle part the same
Latter part the same kept of NW under
double reef topsails
at Lat 38 30 N Long 38 50 W

Mon July Commences with a gale from S by E
the 13th steering W by N under double reef topsails
Middle part the same hove to under double
reef close reef main topsail
Latter part much the same one sail in sight
at Lat 38 34 N Long 38 30 W

Tues July Commences with moderate breeze and
the 14th heavy sea from N by E double reef topsails
and kept of Spike Bush George of N by E
and grimed with her
Middle part the same heading to the westward
Latter part light breeze from S steering
W by N all sail out
back and Mike of duty
at Lat 38 04 N
