Middle part the same
At daylight saw three large whales
Succeeded in striking one at ten 10 AM got the
Whale along side the ship Latter part light breeze
Lat. 40° 41' N. Long 75° 55' W.

Friday
Sept 18th

Commences with a light breeze from N.E.
Employed cutting. at dark lashed down for the
night Middle part the same
Latter part moderate still cutting
Lat. 39° 44' N. Long 76° 09' W.

Saturday
Sept 19th

Commences with moderate breeze from E.
At six am finished cutting & started the works
Middle part the same heading S.E.
Latter part moderate from N.E.
Employed Boiling
Lat. 39° 22' N. Long 76° 44' W.

Sunday
Sept 20th

Commences with light breeze from N.E.
Middle & Latter parts the same
Still Boiling
Lat. 39° 22' N. Long 75° 30' W.

Monday
Sept 21st

Commences with moderate breeze from N.E.
Employed Boiling & running down oil
Middle part moderate
Latter part strong breeze from E.
Still boiling
Lat. 39° 16' N. Long 75° 10' W.

Tuesday
Sept 22nd

Commences with strong breeze from E.
Middle part moderate & equally at ten 10 AM.
Finished boiling Latter part strong breeze
from E.N.E.
Lat. 39° 26' N. Long 74° 40' W.

Wednesday
Sept 23rd

Commences with strong breeze from E.N.E.
Middle part more moderate & equally
Heading North by the wind
Latter part strong breeze from E.N.E.
Employed was King ship's heading South East by the
Wind. Ship under double reef Topsails
Lat. 39° 41' N. Long 74° 54' W.

Thursday
Sept 24th

Commences with a strong breeze from E.N.E.
Heading S.E. by the wind employed washing ship
Middle part the same
Latter part the same ship under double
Reef Topsails heading S.E. by the wind
Lat. 39° 01' N. Long 73° 52' W.

Friday
Sept 25th

Commences with a strong breeze from E.N.E.
Ship under double reef Topsails & Course's
Jib & Spanker
Middle part more moderate at midnight
Turned the reef out of the main brace &
Set fly Jib. heading S.E. by the wind
Latter part the same at noon lashed ship
heading N.E. one sail in sight
Lat. Long.

Saturday
Sept 26th

Commences with a moderate breeze from E.N.E.
Middle part the same from E.N.E.
Heading E.N.E. with all sail set
Latter part moderate & fine weather
Employed setting up fore top gallant rigging &
Breaking out S. Tops. at 11 am made 4 holes steering
East
Lat. Long.

Sunday
Sept 27th
