Sept 27th

Back Sarah of Mattapoisett
Commences with a moderate breeze from S.E.
At 4 P.M. Flores N.E. point bears S.E. dist 30 miles
At sun set double reefed the topsails &
And furled the fly jib
Middle part light breeze & fine weather
From S. Latter part the same.
Lat 28.50 Long 20.58 W.

Monday
Sept 28th

Commences with light breeze & fine weather.
At sun set Flores bearing S.
Heading S.W. by the wind
Middle part the same from S.W.
Latter " " " North east point of
Flores bearing S.W. dist. 15 m
Employed Coopering Oil
Cook still sick and off duty.

Tuesday
Sept 29th

Commences with a light breeze & fine weather
Heading S.W. by the wind
Employed Coopering Oil.
At four P.M. got a fine fish from a boat off Flores
At sun set calm & fine weather
Ship in the passage between Flores & Flores
Middle part light breeze from S.
At 7 P.M. Capt & a boat's crew went on shore at
Santa Cruz. remainder of the day Calm.

Wednesday
Sept 30th

Commences with fine weather & light breeze from the
Westward. at five P.M. received. Potatoes. Onions
Squashes. Eggs. & sent on shore in return. 3 1/2 lbs.
Black Fish Oil. middle part fine weather
And light breeze from W. Heading S.E.
With all sail out at 7 A.M. Pico. bearing S.E.
Latter part moderate employed breaking out
Oil. one sail in sight.

Thursday
Oct 1st

Commences with fine weather & light breezes
From S.W. steering S.E. by S.
Employed bending cables
At 1 P.M. spoke The Bark George
Two days from Pico at 4 P.M. Pico S.W.
Point bearing S.E. dist. 20 m
Middle part light air from S.
Latter part the same Capt & a boat's crew
Started for shore

Friday
Oct 2nd

Commences with fine weather & light air
At five P.M. put fourteen 14 cask & four 4 barrel
Of oil into a lighter for shore
At seven P.M. Capt came onboard
Bark in the passage between Pico & Pico
Middle part the same heading on different
Tracks. at half past seven spoke the
Bark Willis.
Latter part Calm. bark five miles south west
Of Pico harbor.

Sat.
Oct 3rd

Commences with light breeze from S.W.
At one P.M. dropped anchor in Pico harbor.
At three P.M. put fourteen cask of Oil
Into a lighter for shore
Middle part the same.
Latter part fine weather
Employed washing ship's out side.
Still at anchor.

Sunday
Oct 4th

Commences with fine weather & light breeze from S.W.
Discharged Mr. Sherman.
Middle & Latter parts the same.
Still at anchor.
