Thursday Oct 15th Commences with moderate breeze
from E N E Ship steering S half W with
all sail out Latter part weather
the same Also steering the same
The watch employed in ship's duty
Lat 6.40 23.48
Long 150.22

Friday Oct 16th This twenty four hours begins
with strong breeze from the N E
Ship steering S by W with all sail out
Latter the same steering S with all
sail out The watch employed in making
a new turpotion for the rig works
Lat 6.40 21.00
Long 150.18

Saturday Oct 17th Begins with very strong trade
winds Ship steering to the southward
with main top & all sail out Latter
more moderate Ship steering S by W
with all sail out The bark Katchichas
in sight The watch employed in starting
water
Lat 18.37
Long 151.15

Sunday Oct 18th Commences with moderate
breeze from the N Ship heading S S W
Latter part light wind from the Northward
Ship steering S by W with all sail out
Lat 6.40 16.57
Long 151.00

Monday Oct 19th This twenty four hours light
breeze from N N W Ship steering S W with all
sail out Spoke the Barque Katchichas Latter
part light air from N N W Ship steering
W by South The watch employed in setting
up the main rigging
Lat 6.40 16.15
Long 150.21

Tuesday Oct 20th Commences with light breeze
Ship steering W W with all sail out
Rogue new tangards to the foretop & all backstays
Latter part weather the same Lightest breeze
with bearing to the Northward & Westward
steering W S W with all sail out Lat 15.58
Long 22.40

Wednesday Oct 21th This twenty four hours begins
with light breeze from the Northward steering
W S W 5 o'clock P M saw land bearing
W by S Latter part moderate breeze 2 o'clock
P M boat under Masts and at ten A M
came to anchor in Port Paga. St Jago com-
menced to raft water cargo &c

Thursday Oct 22th Light breeze took our anchor and
dropped chain to nearly the centre of the harbour
The watch employed in painting the barke bands
Also hoisted in four casks of water Latter part
light breeze with a heavy swell from S E Took
on board a quantity of fruit and hoisted
in another raft of water four casks & 70 gal

Friday Oct 23th This twenty four hours light
breeze Ship lying at anchor as above increased
Took on board 8 pigs &c Latter part weather
the same Three men missing supposed to
have swam to parts unknown Reported to
some to the authorities on shore Took on
board 8 pigs and a quantity of fowl
Launched one of the spare boats
