as usual S E trade winds with occasional
squalls of rain Ship heaving S E by S
under whole top sails & aback PM set the
main top gallant sail. Mistelle and latter

Monday Nov 16th Begins with a strong breeze from
S E by S ship on the port tack with main
top gallant sail out Mistelle and latter
part the same Employed in plaining the
knots down to a level with the deck

Tuesday Nov 17th This twenty four hours begins
with fine weather ship on the port tack heaving
S E by S & S S W to the wind Mistelle and latter
part much the same Employed in overhauling
the grating around the skylight Lat 7.38

usual Ship heaving S with all sail out
Mistelle part the same latter part sail
from the Coast Ship steering S by W
Employed in running lines &c Lat 11.56

Thursday Nov 19th This twenty four hours begins
fine weather moderate breeze from N E
Ship steering S by W with all sail out
Mistelle and latter part the same
Employed in turning up the main rigging

Friday Nov 20th This day commences with mod-
erate breeze from N E Ship steering
S by W Saw some fin back whales
Mistelle and latter part strong breeze
from the same quarter Ship steering S S W
with all sail out Employed in breaking
out and sailerizing No obs

Saturday Nov 21th Begins again with a good
breeze from N E Ship steering S by W
Mistelle and latter part the same
Several sail in sight Lat 7.05.18.38

Long 74.00.28.42

Sunday Nov 22nd Strong breeze from N E. Stormy
with main top gallant sail out. 5 o'clock I observed
the Island of Brimela. Began close in to the
island & land and got an observation 5 o'clock
steered off S W by S
