from N E 4 o'clock P M tacked
to the N W middle and latter
part strong breezes from N E ship
on the starboard tack half past eleven
o'clock raised Comet ahead Lat 28 32

with strong winds from N E ship on the
port tack under double reefed top sails
middle and latter part weather the
same 10 A M tacked ship Lat 28 47

from the Northward ship on the star-
board tack under double reefed top sails
middle and latter part weather

ening up the stowen beat Lat 28 42

winds ship on the port tack with chub-
-breefed fore top sail 5 o'clock P M tacked
Ship heading N W & W middle part
weather the same Carried away the
fore top sail yard. Latter part wine
light Employed in making another
top sail yard out of an old lower yard
Lat 28 57
Long 46 05

Wednesday Apr 6th This twenty four hours
Commences with calm weather middle
part light airs from the westward
middle and latter part calm and
strong breezes squalls and rain
Ship working and steering to
the N E 99 Finished the top sail
yard sent it aloft and bent the sail
Lat 28 10
Long 46 38
