 bent new stay and secured the hatch-
 ways. No part of and made a new
 main spencer topinlet Middle part
 weather squally with more moderate
 intermissions 2 o'clock A M reared ship
 and at four A M set close reefed
 main topsail and fore sail stay light
 made more sail 12 o'clock noon
 had the topgallant yards aloft
 and the main topgallant sail set

 pilot came on board took the anchor and
 steered for St Cathrins and after dragging
 through the mud came to anchor off that
 town a little past noon
