 Wednesday Apr 13<sup>th</sup> This twenty four hours commences with weather as usual I suppose it would be proper to keep my log & civil account but I commenced this still and shall keep in the same form  
 Weather somewhat cloudy through the middle and latter part with light rain in the P.M. One watch on liberty Got off a small raft of water

Thursday Apr 14<sup>th</sup> Weather the same Ship still laying as before the middle part heavy thunder storms with considerable wind latter part fine weather with wind from the southwest Ship laying still the same One watch on liberty the other employed in stowing watercocks &c

Friday Apr 15<sup>th</sup> This twenty four hours begins with fine weather Ship still laying the same Middle and latter part raining  
 Employed in getting off water Also took on board 2 barrels of sugar and one bag of coffee

Saturday Apr 16<sup>th</sup> This twenty four hours begins with clear weather with strong breezes from the South Middle and latter part the same Got off another raft of water Sent one shore 4 barrels of bread and took on board 552 coconuts that is they are about that number more or less possible they may vary two or three

*In At Catapina*  
 Sunday Apr 17<sup>th</sup> Commences with heavy strong breezes from the South Middle and latter part fine weather  
 Ship still laying as before mentioned  
 Sent all lunch on shore to have a run

Monday Apr 18<sup>th</sup> This twenty four hours commences with light breezes from the southwest No alteration in the position of the Ship Middle and latter part very light air from the north which is right ahead for us Took on board 100 lbs coffee finished stowing hides &c

Tuesday Apr 19<sup>th</sup> This twenty four hours begins with light air from the North Ship still in her old position ready to move down to Santa Cruz  
 Middle and latter part the same One watch on shore

Wednesday Apr 20<sup>th</sup> This day wind from North Ship laying the same Middle and latter part the same one watch on shore

Thursday Apr 21<sup>th</sup> Wind from North very light Ship waiting for a wind to go down to Santa Cruz Middle part calm latter part light wind from the south Got under way and dropped down to the flats and came to anchor to wait for high water
