 N N E Saw a water spout
 Middle and Latter part squally and
 rainy with occasionally strong breezes from
 S E Ship steering N N E
 Caught water and filled the butt and
 all emptiness. Carved away the mast studding
 sail

Monday May 16th This twenty four hours
 begins with rain and squalls Ship steer-
 ing N N E Several sail in sight
