14

Bark Sarah starting on a ^{voyage} Whaling
Remarks on board July 14 1864
This twenty four hours commencing
lying at anchor in the harbor of
Mattapoisett at 10 AM got underway
Hood out in to the bay

Friday
15

commenced with light winds from the
NE our ship still at anchor waiting
for men at five came to anchor off
clarks point light middle part fine
lying at anchor latter part all hand
on board at 6 o'clock AM got our
anchors and went to sea at ten
stead anchors and chains at 12
late boat leaving North heading SE

Saturday
16

commenced with cloudy weather and
strong breeze from the NE ship heading
to the SE W under double reef topsails
middle part the same in plough
firing boats
Lat 38 49 Long 69 50

Sunday
17

commenced with strong breeze from NE
at three AM took in main topsail
middle part the same heading to
the south and East latter part the same
Lat 38 26 Long 69 00

Monday
18

commenced with heavy weather ship under
main spencer and fore top mast stay sail
middle part the same latter part more
moderate at the topsails wind from
the South were ship heading to the East
Lat 37 00 Long 68 00

Tuesday
19

commenced with moderate wind from
the South and West heading SE
with double reef topsails and courses
middle part the same latter part
fine weather at 6 AM masted all sail
ship by the wind to Eastward

Wednesday
20

commenced with fine weather and light winds
from East South East ship by the wind
heading SE were sail in light heading
NE middle part the same latter part
moderate at sea from the Eastward
heading to the South and Eastward
with all sail set Lat 37 00 Long 63 26

Thursday
21

commenced with fine weather and moderate
winds from NW ship with all sail
set heading East by South backing out
main middle part spaly latter part
strong breeze from SW with some
rain at noon double reef topsails

Friday
22

commenced with strong breeze from
SW ship running with single reef
topsails middle part the same
latter part about the same
Lat 37 11 Long 58 33

Saturday
23

commenced with fine weather wind
strong from SW ship under single
reef topsails courses at 5 PM more
moderate turned the reefs out and
set the gill and flying gill ship
heading East middle and latter
part the same latter part
wind from SW heading East by South
Lat 37 36 Long 54 53

Sunday
24

this day commenced with fine weather and
moderate breeze from the SW ship heading
East by South with all sail middle part
fine with light winds from SW
ship running with all sail set
Lat 38 20 Long 54 10
