sails of our sea Lat 39 45 Long 39 15

Wednesday Aug 24 This twenty four hours
comesis with heavy weather double
reef main topsail and fairsail
at three P.M. set the four topsail
ship heading North by the wind
saw ship inside middle part
weather the same latter part set
four topsail and mainsail strong
breeze and spaly Lat 40 30 Long 40 00

Thursday Aug 25 This Twenty four hours
comesis with strong breeze and
spaly weather wind S^W ship
under double reef topsails and
courses heading N^W middle
part the same latter part
fresh winds from SE set
main top gage sail
plenty of rain seals
Lat 40 56 Long 40 50

Friday August 26 This Twenty four
hours comesis with spaly weather
saw a big heading to the South
middle part weather the same
latter part strong wind from N^E
double reef topsails ship running
South East by South Lat 40 52 Long
40 15

Sat Aug 27 This Twenty four hours
comesis with strong breeze
from north ship heading ESE
at sundown were round heading
to the west ward middle and
latter part fine at 11 o'clock Raised
Whale board and chart till dark
Whale going fast wind tide could
not get up to him Lat 40 44 Long 39 55

Sunday Aug 28 This Twenty four hours
comesis with fine weather
wind South west middle the same
latter part weather getting bad
Raining double reef the topsails
and fairsail mainsail and gib
saw a ship to the land
Catching a whale no observation

Monday Aug 29 This Twenty four hours
comesis with strong wind from
N^S W and raining the marcella
Crosby spoke in and the captain
went on board he saw Whales
yesterday middle part weather
the same latter part spoke the
Dr. Tucker 75 lbs strong
double reef topsails breeze
saw five sails to day
Lat 40 25 Long 39 15
