

Wednesday October 18 This Twenty four hours commens with strong winds from the West ship heading No No West double reef topsails middle part blew strong take in four topsails at day lite let it again ship all day heading No No East wind N W no Latitude today

Thursday Oct 20 This Twenty four hours commens with strong wind from N W bent four topsail and work on regen middle part wind held southe then back to the West blew very hard and rained hard at seven A M calm wind held East moderate wind set topsails and main topgallant sail

Friday Oct 21 This Twenty four hours commens with moderate winds from N E at five wind held to the N and East middle part blew a fine breeze from N W latter part blew strong under close reef main topsail and foresail took a stick of timber a long time hoisted up war end found it poor let go again rove new topsail brasses

Saturday 22 This Twenty four hours commens with but rather heavy squalls took in main topsail middle and latter part the same

Sunday October 23 This Twenty four hours commens with heavy squalls at P M let main topsail and foresail and wore ship bedding to the west middle part let main sail and gib latter part wind lite maid all sail sent up four top gallant yard in Lat 38 26 Long 46 35

Monday Oct 24 This Twenty four hours commens with fine weather almost calm wind from S W middle part blowing very from S W middle part the sail at war No blew rising broke tear the sail so we sent it down at three and went to work on it by the lite of the lantern

Tuesday Oct 25 This Twenty four hours commens with heavy weather wind west bent the main topsail and furl it in laying with main Spencer and fore topmast stays all day middle part moderated maid sail latter part let all sail wind North No Longitude Lat 39 54

Wednesday Oct 26 This Twenty four hours commens with fine weather and a heavy swell wind N E ship heading West by North middle part blew hard and raised latter part moderated let the four topsail and main sail ran into a school of Whales at eight o'clock in the morning heard several boat struck and killed in war very rugged no Long Lat 40 55
