Sailed 1st of May 1865

Monday May the 1 this day comes in with
fine weather and wind from N.E. at 9 P.M.
the Seem boat were us out at 10 P.M.
the wind held to E. So ends this day

Tuesday May the 2 this day comes in with rain
& haphing winds all hands employed ship
duty at 4 P.M. the wind to N.E. steering
S by E. Middle part rainy latter part fine
weather all sail got steering S by E
So ends this day

Wednesday May the 3 this day comes
in with light winds from E all sail
got steering S by E. Middle & latter part
strong gales & rain at 11 P.M. double reefed
the top sails saw a shoal off blackside
So ends this day

Thursday May the 4 this day comes in with strong gales
A wind squally at 5 P.M. turned one reef out
of the main top sail & steering S.E. Middle
part more moderate at sail got steering S
So ends this day

Long in 69 27 W
Friday May the 5 this day comes in with strong winds
from all sail got steering S.E. Middle
and latter part fine weather wind from S.W.
all hands employed in ship duty
So ends this day
