Sunday May the 28 this day Comes in with strong gales from N.E.W at 2 PM the gale moderated down but the main top Sail & lost reefed Middle & latter part the same to ends this day

Monday May the 29 this day Comes in with strong gales from N.E.W. under lost reef top Main top Sail Middle & latter part the same to ends this day

Tuesday May the 30 this day Comes in with strong gales from N.E.W heading W at 4 PM under lost reef main top Sail & foreail middle and latter part fresh gales double reef top Sails and gill & spanker to ends this day

Wednesday May the 31 this day Comes in with fresh gales from N.E.W under double reefed top Sail Middle part the same latter part fresh breezes from N.E.W all Sail got Steering N.E.W. Saw one Sail Bound & to ends this day

Thursday June the 1 this day Comes in with strong winds from W at 4 PM all Sail got Steering N.E.W at sundown took in Sail for the night Middle & latter part strong gales from W at 11 PM rain saw blackfish going quick to windward to ends this day

Friday June the 2 this day Comes in with fresh gales from N.E.W under double reefed top Sails Steering N.E.W Middle & latter part more moderate at daylight turned the reef out of the top Sails & saw penbucks to ends this day

Saturday June the 3 this day Comes in with fresh gales from N.E.W Steering E at 2 PM double reefed the top Sails at sunset took in the fore top Sail & lost reefed the Main top Sail & luffed to heading N middle & latter part the same to ends this day

Sunday June the 4 this day Comes in with strong gales from W to N.W Steering E at 4 PM double reef top Sails Middle & latter part the same to ends this day

Monday June the 5 this day Comes in with fresh gales from N.E.W heading E at 5 PM Spoke the Ship Janus of New Bedford 35 moun, out 1700 lbs Capt. Middle & latter part more moderate at daylight made Sail heading E Saw penbucks to ends this day

Tuesday June the 6 this day Comes in with fresh breezes from N.E.W all Sail got heading E at 4 PM Spoke the Ship Janus of New Bedford at sunset took in Sail for the night Middle part the same latter part strong gales from N.E.W at 10 PM took in the Main Sail and fore top Sail & lost reefed the Main top Sail to ends this day

Wednesday June the 7 this day Comes in with strong gales from N.E.W and rain heading W under lost reef main top Sail at 3 PM Saw a Merchantman hove to under a lost reef Main top Sail Middle part the same latter part strong breezes all Sail got at 6 PM lowered the boats for blackfish at 8 PM came on bore without success and saw several Sails bound W to ends this day
