Thursday June the 8 this day comes in with strong winds from E. & S. all sail set heading N at sunset took in sail for the night Middle & latter part strong gales from E & S and rain laying to under close reef main top sail So Ends this day

Friday June the 9 this day comes in with strong gales from E. & S. laying to under close reef main top sail & heading N Middle part the same latter part Modest all sail set Steering N by E So Ends this day
Lat in 43° 21' N
Long in 34° 39' W

Saturday June the 10 this day comes in with fine weather wind from S & E all sail set Steering N by E at sunset took in sail for the night Middle & latter part the same at 12 M. Saw black fish lower the boats at 2 PM came on board with out success So Ends this day

Sunday June the 11 this day comes in with light winds & squally at sunset took in sail for the night middle & latter part the same all sail set So Ends this day

Monday June the 12 this day comes in with fresh winds from W all sail set at 11 PM spoke the ship the ship Sams for of Bedford at sunset took in sail for the night Middle & latter part the at daylight made all sail So Ends this day

Tuesday June the 13 this day comes in with fine weather all sail set wind from at Sundown took in sail of the night Middle & latter part the same at daylight made all sail & saw several sails So Ends this day

Wednesday June the 14 this day comes in with fresh winds from S. W all sail set heading W by N at sunset took in sail for the night Middle part the same latter part thick fog & rain at 11 PM cleared up So Ends this day
Lat in 42° 36' N

Thursday June the 15 this day comes in with fine weather all sail set wind from N. W at sunset took in sail for the night Middle & latter part light winds and thick fog & rain all sail set So Ends this day

Friday June the 16 this day comes in with thick fog all sail set at Sundown took in sail for the night Middle & latter part fine weather all sail set braking out the fore hole for sails & water So Ends this day
Lat in 41° 17' N
Long in 33° 37' W

Saturday June the 17 this day comes in with fresh breezes under double reef top sails at 6 PM saw several whales going quick to E. S. & at 7 PM lowered the boats at 8 PM came on board with out success middle & latter part strong gales and rain under double reef main top sail & forecast So Ends this day
Lat in 41° 12' N
Long in 33° 55' W

Sunday June the 18 this day comes in with fresh gales from W and rail middle and latter part strong gales under double reef top sails wind from S. W heading W. N. W So Ends this day

Monday June the 19 this day comes in with fresh gales from S. W heading W. N. W. Saw 10 sails bound to Eastward Middle and latter strong gale and rain So Ends this day
