Monday July the 10 this day comes in with light winds from East all sail set bound in to payall Captain Baker very Sick and the other Borden Mrs Spencer not So bad all the rest we are unwell Except on Portigue Sick with lads fever Middle and latter part the same So Ends this day

Tuesday July the 11 this day comes in with fine weather W from S W Steering E S E Captain the same Mr Borden the same Spencer is a kicking Middle & latter part fine weather at 7 P M Saw the land the Captain and Mrs Borden the same at 8 P M but
