Wednesday August the 2 this day comes in with strong gales from S & under close reef main top sail heading W by N middle & latter part the same to ends this day

Thursday August the 3 this day comes in with fresh gales from S & under double reef top sails & fore sail heading S by E middle & latter part the same to ends this day

Friday August the 4 this day comes in with fine weather all sail got heading to S by E at 1 PM spoke the Sloop of New Bedford at 6 PM engaged with the barque President middle & latter part fine weather to ends this day

Saturday August the 5 this day comes in with fine weather all sail to work in the rigging middle & latter part the same to ends this day

Sunday August the 6 this day comes in with fine weather all sail got at 7 PM wore ship to W wind from S middle & latter part the same to ends this day

Monday August the 7 this day comes in with light airs from S & heading W middle part the same latter part light winds from W by N all sail got to ends this day

Tuesday August the 8 this day comes in with fresh breezes from W by N all sail got saw 2 sperm whales at sunset took in sail & wore ship to S by E middle & latter part the same at daylight made sail at 8 AM saw 3 sperm whales at 9 lowered barbed boat struck to ends this day

Wednesday August the 9 this day comes in with fine weather employed whaling at 2 PM took a whale along side and kept up for the boats at 5 PM raised the boats at 6 PM the boats come along side at 7 PM commenced buting at 11 PM got through cutting & got the watch at daylight employed blaring away for boyling at 9 AM started the fires all hands employed bleering the decks to ends this day

Thursday August the 10 this day comes in with fine weather employed boyling at 5 PM wore ship to S by E middle & latter part calm employed boyling to ends this day

Saturday Aug the 12 this day comes in with light airs from S heading S by E middle & latter part fresh breezes at daylight made sail heading from S by E to S by E at 8 AM saw 2 sperm whales at 10 AM lowered the boats at 11 AM the barbed boat struck to ends this day

Sunday August the 13 this day comes in with strong breezes from S at 3 PM took the whale along side at 4 PM commenced buting weather squally at 7 PM lashed down the pear middle and latter part strong gales from W by N at daylight broke out the blubber room at 7 PM commenced buting at 10 AM got the head of to ends this day

Monday August the 14 this day comes in with fresh gale from W by N at 2 PM got the body in & cleared away the saw & got edy to start the fire middle & latter strong gales at 7 AM hooked on the head to ends this day
