Tuesday August the 29 this day comes in with strong gales and rain wind all round the compass under double reef top Sails and forecail Middle part the same latter part modret wind from S S W Steering E
So Ends this day Lat in 36.27 Long in 44.48 W

Wednesday August the 30 this day comes in with fine weather wind from S S W Steering E at Sundown took in Sail Middle & latter part the same all Sail got to Sails in sight So Ends this day

Thursday August the 31 this day comes in with strong winds & squally at 3 Pm spoke the Barque Vision of New Bedford and let her have a bout Middle & latter part strong gales & squally So Ends this day

Friday September the 1 this day comes in with strong gales and squalls of rain under double reef top Sails at Sundown took in the fore top Sail and lost reefed the main top Sail Middle & latter part the same So Ends this day

Saturday Sep the 2 this day comes in with strong gales from N W and plenty of rain laying to under a lost reef main top Sail Middle part the same latter part more modret at daylight got double reef top Sails & jib & main sail wind from N W heading at So Ends this day Lat in 36.44 Long in 42.31 W

Sunday Sep the 3 this day comes in with fine weather all Sail got wind from N W heading at at Sundown took in Sail for the night Middle & latter part strong breezes under double reef top Sails at 7 Pm saw a whole of sperm whales lowered & all the boats struck So Ends this day

Monday Sep the 4 this day comes in with strong breezes under double reef top Sails at 1 Pm took 3 Whales along Side at 1 Pm commenced buting at 4 Pm got through buting & sent down the hulls & set them atch Middle part strong gales and rain looked down at daylight blered up started the fire So Ends this day

Tuesday Sep the 5 this day comes in with strong winds from W heading at N W Middle & latter part the same Employ in boyling at 11 A m got through boyling So Ends this day Lat in 36.46 Long in 42.56 W

Wednesday Sep the 6 this day comes in with fresh gales from N W heading at at Sundown took in Sail Middle & latter part more modret Employ in blowing down eye So Ends this day Lat in 37.09 Long in 42.56 W

Thursday Sep the 7 this day comes in with strong winds from under double reef top Sails an forecail Middle & latter part fine weather at daylight got all Sail one sail in sight Employed in Ship duty So Ends this day Lat in 37.20 Long in 42.40 W

Friday Sep the 8 this day comes in with fresh winds from N W at 2 Pm double reef the top Sails at 4 Pm took in jib & main sail at 6 took in the fore top sail Middle & latter part strong gales from W laying to under a lost reef main top Sail So Ends this day

Saturday Sep the 9 this day comes in with strong gales from W heading at N W laying to under a lost reef main top Sail middle part the same latter more modret at 7 Pm made Sail gave one Sail So Ends this day Lat in 37.15 Long in 41.37 W
