

Log kept on Board Barge

Saturday Sept the 23 this day comes in with fine weather wind from S. S. E. all sail got heading 4 1/2 W Middle & latter part light winds & baffling 4 sails in sight So Ends this day
Lat in 39° 12' N
Long in 32° 41' W

Sunday Sept the 24 this day comes in with fresh winds from S. S. E. at 4 P.M. the wind haled to S. S. E. wore ship to E Middle & latter part winds baffling at daylight saw Hecar bearing E. S. E. by compass distance 40 miles or there abouts So Ends this day Lat in 39° 44' N
Long in 31° 30' W

Monday Sept the 25 this day comes in with strong winds & baffling heading from E. to E. S. E. at sundown took in the light sails barrow bearing S. E. distance 4 leagues or there abouts Middle & latter part the same at daylight barrow bore W distance 15 miles or there abouts all sail got steering S. E. by S So Ends this day

Tuesday Sept the 26 this day comes in with fresh winds from W. S. W. all sail got steering S. E. by E Middle & latter part the same at daylight saw Fayall bearing S. S. E. and rain So Ends this day

Wednesday Sept the 27 this day comes in with fresh winds from S. S. W. at 5 P.M. the wind haled to W. S. W. at 4 P.M. came to anchor at Fayall the Captain went on shore & sent a large anchor Middle & latter part fine weather at 6 P.M. commenced breaking out the oyl at 11 P.M. sent one lighter of oyl on shore So Ends this day

Thursday Sept the 28 this day comes in with fine weather employed breaking out oyl & carrying it 4 P.M. got it all on deck Middle & latter part passing signals of rain employed setting shrouks So Ends this day

Harbor of New Bedford 1865

Friday Sept the 29 this day comes in with a strong wind from N. E. and a heavy swell Middle & latter part the same could not land oyl there was so much surf on the beach employed setting up shrouks So Ends this day

Saturday Sept the 30 this day comes in with light winds from S. E. and a heavy surf on the beach stood the blubber one side and filed it with salt water Middle & latter the same So Ends this day

Sunday Oct the 1 this day comes in with strong winds from W. S. W. & a heavy surf on the shore Middle & latter part the same one watch on liberty Charles
Charles Campbell ran away trying to anchor at Fayall So Ends this day

Monday Oct the 2 this day comes in with strong winds from S. at 2 P.M. the lighter came and took the oyl on shore and watch on liberty So Ends this day

Tuesday Oct the 3 this day comes in with strong winds from S employed setting up shrouks & hauling down barge President and the Barge Ohio of New Bedford laying off and on Middle & latter part the same one watch on liberty So Ends this day

Wednesday Oct the 4 this day comes in with fresh winds from S. W. laying to anchor at Fayall employed setting up shrouks So Ends this day

Thursday Oct the 5 this day comes in with equally weather Barge Triton Cornal & Barge Wave handy laying off and on So Ends this day

Friday Oct the 6 this day comes in with fresh winds and equally at 5 P.M. took the anchor and went to sea Middle part equally latter strong breezes from S. steering S. E. So Ends this day
