Saturday Oct the 7 this day comes in with strong breezes from N.E. all sail set Steering S.E. at 5 P.M. took in the light sails Middle & latter part the same at daylight Saw gorge bore S.E. distance 8 miles or there abouts Go Ends this day

Sunday Oct the 8 this day comes in with strong winds and passing squalls of rain. Part Mikes in sight under double reefed top sails Middle & latter part the same at 7 P.M. turned the reef out of the main top sail Steering S.E. wind N.W. Go Ends this day.

Lat in 36° 05' N Long in 23° 21' W

Monday Oct 9 this day comes in with fresh gales from N.W. Steering S.E. at 6 P.M. Charles King came aft and told the Captain he had nothing to eat the Captain asked him if there was now meat he said yes but it was not fit for dogs to eat the meat was brought aft there was a reef for 5 men in the hold he said he could not eat it and should not work till he had something to eat and started forward and said he should not work till he had something fit to eat put him in irons & put him in the room Middle & latter part strong gales from N.W. under double reefed topsails at 8 P.M. Charles King wanted to come out of irons & go to duty Go Ends this day

Tuesday Oct 10 this day comes in with strong gales from N.E. Steering S.E. under double reefed top sails Middle and latter part fine weather all sail set Steering S.E. broke out the sails & bent the new main top sail Go Ends this day Lat in 33° 03' N

Long in 21° 29' W

Wednesday Oct the 11 this day comes in with fine weather all sail set Steering S.E. at 4 P.M. bent the main top sail forward Middle & latter part fine weather all sail set Go Ends this day Lat in 32° 36' N

Long in 20° 34' W

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Thursday Oct the 12 this day comes in with light winds from N.E. all sail set Steering S.E. employed in ship duty Middle & latter part gabner employed repairing the main sail Go Ends this day Lat in 32° 24' N

Long in 20° 28' W

Friday Oct 13 this day comes in with light airs from N.W. Steering S.E. at Middle & latter part light winds from N.W. all sail set Steering S.E. Go Ends this day

Saturday Oct 14 this day comes in with light winds from N.W. Steering S.E. repairing the main sail Middle & latter part the same Go Ends this day Lat in 32° 14' N

Long in 17° 29' W

Sunday Oct the 15 this day comes in with light breezes & falling barometer in sight at sundown it bore S.E. 5 leagues or there abouts Middle & latter part strong gales & rain at 2 P.M. double reefed the top sails on look in the gale & main sail Go Ends this day Lat in 31° 22' N

Long in 16° 48' W

Monday Oct the 16 this day comes in with fresh gales from N.E. under double reef top sail & fore sail Middle and latter part the same employed setting up shrouds at daylight Saw the Selwicks bearing S.E. Go Ends this day

Tuesday Oct the 17 this day comes in with fresh gales from N.E. under double reef top sails Steering S.E. Middle & latter part the same at daylight Saw the land bearing S.E. distance 5 leagues or there abouts employed setting up jacks Go Ends this day

Wednesday Oct the 18 this day comes in with strong winds from N.E. Steering S.E. Middle & latter light winds Go Ends this day

Thursday Oct the 19 this day comes in with light winds from N.E. all sail set Steering S.E. Middle & latter part the same Go Ends this day
