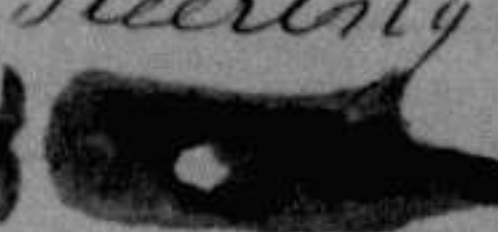
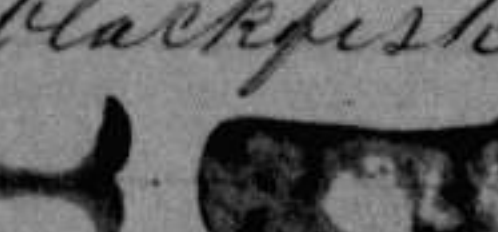
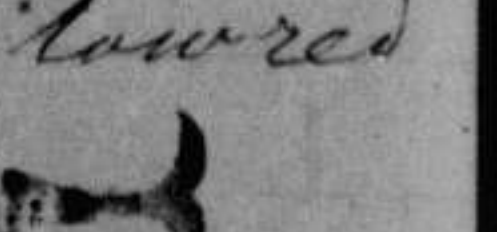


Log kept on Board Barque Sarah

sail so ends this day.

Saturday Oct the 21 this day comes in with light winds
from N.E. all sail got steering S.W. by S. Middle & latter part
the same at daylight kept off S.W. by S. repairing the fore
top galant sail so ends this day.

Sunday Oct the 22 this day comes in with light
winds from N.E. all sail got steering S.W. by S. at
1 P.M. two blackfish towed and got to harbor
boat & harbor boat got one Middle & latter part the
same so ends this day.

Monday Oct the 23 this day comes in with light
winds from N.E. steering S.W. two blackfish towed
& got 4     

Middle and latter part strong breezes from N.E. all sail got
steering S.W. at 7 P.M. commenced hoisting so ends this day.

Tuesday Oct the 24 this day comes in with strong winds
from N.E. all sail got steering S.W. at 3 P.M. got through
hoisting Middle & latter part the same steering S.W.
so ends this day. Lat in 18° 42' N Long in 181° 1' W.

Wednesday the 25 this day comes in with strong winds
from N.E. all sail got steering S.W. Middle and
latter part the same employed mending the fore top
galant sail at 10 P.M. saw the land bearing S.W.
so ends this day. Lat in 16° 30' N Long in 220° 11' W.

Thursday Oct the 26 this day comes in with fine weather
wind from S.E. all sail got steering S.W. by S. Middle and
latter part the same at 7 P.M. saw the Island of Mayo bearing
S.W. distance 5 leagues or thereabouts at 10 P.M. saw the Island
of St.ago so ends this day.

Friday Oct the 27 this day comes in with strong S.E.
trades at 1 P.M. came to anchor at Port Pray S.E.
of St.ago Middle & latter part the same got one raft of water
so ends this day.

Saturday Oct the 28 this day comes in with strong trades at
1 P.M. the Barque Briton of New Bedford came to anchor
& employed getting of water so ends this day.

Sunday October the 29 this day comes in with strong
trades day to anchor at Port Pray at 3 P.M. the Barque
waave of New Bedford came to anchor so ends
this day.

Monday Oct the 30 this day comes in with strong trades
laying to anchor at Port Pray Middle & latter part the
same at 10 P.M. the Barque Briton of New Bedford got
under way so ends this day.

Tuesday Oct the 31 this day comes in with fine
weather laying to anchor at Port Pray S.E.
of St.ago Middle & latter part the same at 6 P.M. took the
anchor & went to sea employed stowing
anchors & clearing up decks so ends this
day.

Wednesday November the 1 this day
comes in with light winds from S.W. steering
S. Middle part S.W. by S. at 1 P.M. hoisted the
gill latter part fine weather employed
repairing the gill so ends this day.
