Sunday the 17 this day comes in with fine weather all sail got Middle & latter part the same saw to sails so ends this day

Monday Dec the 18 this day comes in with strong breezes from N.E. by E all sail got steering at 11 by 11 at sundown took in sail for the night middle & latter equally so ends this day Lat in 33°00' N Long in 48°47' W

Tuesday Dec the 19 this day comes in with strong breezes & hailing at 6 P.M. the wind haled to N.E. by E. Close reefed the main top sail took in the fore top sail & main sail middle & latter part the same at daylight turned the reef out of the top sails so ends this day Lat in 33°54' N Long in 50°31' W

Wednesday Dec the 21 this day comes in with fresh gales double reefed the top sails and took in the fore & mainsail at sundown took in the fore top sail middle & latter part more over at daylight made sail 5 sails in light took out for Bread & flour & water so ends this day Lat in 34°30' N Long in 51°27' W

Thursday Dec the 22 this day comes in with light wind & fine weather all sail so heading N.E. by N middle & latter part fine weather at daylight made all sail employed mending the main top sail so ends this day Lat in 35°00' N Long in 51°09' W

Friday Dec the 23 this day comes in with fine weather all sail got wind from N.E. at 11 by 11 took in sail for the night middle & latter part the same at daylight made sail so ends this day

Barak of New Bedford 1865

Saturday Dec the 24 this day comes in with strong breezes from N.E. by E all sail got saw one sail middle part the same latter part strong gales at 10 P.M. took in the fore sail & fore top sail so ends this day

Sunday Dec the 25 this day comes in with strong gales from N.E. by E under a close reef main top sail main & fore Spencer middle & latter part fine weather at daylight made sail saw one sail so ends this day Lat in 35°10' N Long in 50°44' W

Monday Dec the 26 this day comes in with fine weather all sail got heading to North word middle & latter the same at daylight made sail so ends this day Lat in 34°30' N Long in 49°26' W

Tuesday Dec the 26 this day comes in with fine weather all sail got steering to N.E. by N at 3 P.M. saw a sail at 5 P.M. Wake the John Dawson the Captain was on board at 9 P.M. saw one on board middle part the same latter part strong gales at 7 P.M. kept of N.E. by E under double reef top sails so ends this day Lat in 33°52' N Long in 48°52' W

Wednesday Dec the 27 this day comes in with strong gales under double reef top sails & fore sail steering N.E. by E at sundown took in the fore top sail middle & latter part the same so ends this day

Thursday Dec the 28 this day comes in with strong gales from N.E. by E at 6 P.M. Wake the George Courser of New Bedford middle & latter part the same saw one sail so ends this day sail
