Tuesday Thursday Dec the 29 this day comes in with strong gales & rain at 4 P.M. took in the fore top sail middle & latter part the same & ends this day

Saturday Dec the 30 this day comes in with strong gales from S.W. under close reef main top sail & forecail middle & latter part the same steering N.E. & ends this day

Sunday Dec the 31 this day comes in with strong gales from S.W. steering N.E. middle & latter part strong winds from S.W. all sail got so ends this day  
Lat in 31° 32' N Long in 44° 54' W

January the 1 1866

Monday January the 1 this day comes in with fine weather wind from S.W. all sail got at sundown took in the fore top sail & double reefed the main middle & latter part of strong gales from W.S.W. laying too under close reef main top sail & ends this day  
Lat in 31° 28' N Long in 44° 42' W

Tuesday Jan the 2 this day comes with strong gales from W.S.W. under close reef main top sail middle & latter part the same plenty of rain & ends this day

Wednesday Jan the 3 this day comes in with fresh gales & rain at 1 P.M. cleared up wind from S.W. middle & latter part equally & rain & thunder under double reef top sails steering S.W. by S & ends this day

Thursday Jan the 4 this day came with heavy squalls of rain steering S.W. at sundown took in the fore top sail & close reefed the main top sail middle & latter part the same & ends this day

Bark of New Bedford 1865

Friday Jan the 5 this day comes in with strong gales N.E. under double reefed top sails & forecail steering S.W. by S middle & latter part fine weather at daylight made all sail wind from E.S.E. & ends this day Lat in 33° 34' N Long in 47° 35' W

Saturday Jan the 6 this day comes in with fine weather all sail got ~~under~~ wind from E.S.E. at 6 P.M. saw spouts 3 miles off at sundown took in sail for the night middle & latter part the same at daylight made all sail saw one sail & ends this day Lat in 33° 30' N Long in 48° 03' W

Sunday Jan the 7 this day comes in with strong gales from N.E. under double reef top sails at 1 P.M. spoke the Bargue Wave of New Bedford buting a whale got 100 sperm at 5 P.M. saw breaches to points on the weather bow going quick did not get nigh a nip to see what they was at sundown took in the fore top sail & maincail middle & latter part the same under double reef top sails & forecail & ends this day  
Lat in 33° 13' N Long in 48° 52' W

Monday Jan the 8 this day comes in with fresh gales from E.N.E. under double reef top sails and forecail at 1 P.M. wore ship to S by E middle & latter part the same at daylight made sail & left of W.S.W. & ends this day

Tuesday Jan the 9 this day comes in with fine weather all sail got steering W.S.W. at 5 P.M. spoke the Bargue Seine of New Bedford middle & latter part the same under double reef top sails saw bumpers & ends this day (Sail) Long in 48° 53' W Lat in 33° 30' N

Wednesday Jan the 10 this day comes in with fresh gales from E.S.E. heading S at sundown took in the fore top sail & main sail & close reef the main top sail middle & latter part the same & ends this day  
Long in 48° 30' W
