Tuesday Feb the 27 this day comes in with light winds from S.W steering by N Middle & latter part the same all sail set steering by S to ends this day
Lat in 32° 48' N
Long in 46° 19' W

Wednesday Feb the 28 this day comes in with light winds from W by W all sail set steering by S by S Middle & latter part the same to ends this day

Thursday March the 1 this day comes in with fine weather all sail set wind from S by S at sunset double reefed the top sails Middle and latter part the same to ends this day

Friday March the 2 this day comes in with fresh gales from S by W under double reefed top sails at 6 PM took in the fore top sail & closed reefed the main top sail Middle & latter part the same to ends this day

Saturday March the 3 this day comes in with strong gales from S by W under a close reefed main top sail & fore sail Middle & latter part strong winds from S by W steering by S at 4 PM spoke the Barge John Dawson to ends this day

Sunday Mar the 4 this day comes in with light winds & calms saw a Steamer bound to N & Middle & latter part the same to ends this day

Monday Mar the 5 this day comes in with light winds from N by W by W at 2 PM spoke the John Dawson middle & latter part the same all sail set steering by S to ends this day

Tuesday Mar the 6 this day comes in with light winds from S, S, E at sunset took in sail for the night middle & latter part the same at daylight made all sail saw to sail to ends this day
Lat in 31° 30' S
Long in 43° 48' W

Wednesday Mar the 7 this day comes in with fine weather all sail set wind from S by W at sundown took in sail for the night Middle & latter part strong gales from S by W at 11 PM took in the fore top sail & fore sail and saw to sails to ends this day

Thursday Mar the 8 this day comes in with strong gales from S by W at 4 PM took in the main top sail laying to under a fore & main Spencer middle part the same latter part set the top sails double reefed saw 3 sails to ends this day

Friday Mar the 9 this day comes in with strong gales from S, S, W with double reefed top sails at 7 PM took in the fore top sail and closed reefed the main top sail Middle & latter part strong winds from S to ends this day

Saturday Mar the 10 this day comes in with fine weather wind from S steering by S at sundown double reefed the top sails Middle & latter part the same at daylight made all sail steering by S by S at 9 PM saw a shoal of sperm whales going quick to S, S, E lowered the boats and at 9 PM at 12 PM came on board saw nothing of the whales any more to ends this day
Lat in 30° 50' N Long in 45° 50' W
