Saturday June the 16 this day comes in with fine weather all sail set at 3 PM saw a sail at sundown took in sail for the night Middle & latter part fine weather at daylight made all sail employed in this duty so ends this day Talt in 29th 1st Long in 49th 27th W

Sunday June the 17 this day comes in with fine weather all sail set at sunset took in sail for the night middle & latter part the same at dawn made all sail so ends this day Talt in 29th 2nd Long in 49th 32nd W

Monday the June the 18 this day comes in with strong winds from N all sail set at 3 PM saw a sail and a moidet breeze at sunset took in sail for the night middle & latter part the same at 4 PM lowered the mast Boat and picked up a cask of Palm oil so ends this day Talt in 28th 4th Long in 49th 12th W

Tuesday June the 19 this day comes in with strong breezes from N & double reefed top sails night middle & latter part the same so ends this day Talt in 29th 12th Long in 29th 41st W

Wednesday the 20 this day comes in with strong gales from N & under double reef top sails & foreail middle and latter part the same at daylight made all sail so ends this day Talt in 30th 12th Long in 49th 1st W

Thursday June the 21 this day comes in with fine weather all sail set at 1 PM saw a fire in copales lowered the mast and got one at 5 PM took him aboard ship and at 7 PM got through caulking but put down the cables and got the watch at 7 PM started the fires and commenced boiling so ends this day Talt in 30th 22nd Long in 49th 15th W

Harbor of New Bedford June the 16 1866

Friday June the 22 this day comes in with light airs and calms all sail set employed boiling at 4 PM got through boiling and cleared up decks and took in sails for the night Middle & latter part the same employed mending sails so ends this day Boiling

Saturday June the 23 this day comes in with light winds & calms employed in mending sails at sundown took in the light sails for the night middle & latter part the same employed mending the fore top sail so ends this day Talt in 29th 3rd Long in 49th 33rd W

Sunday June the 24 this day comes in with light winds and passing squalls of rain at sundown took in sail for the night Middle & latter part passing squalls of rain so ends this day Talt in 30th 00th Long in 49th 25th W

Monday June the 25 this day comes in with passing squalls of rain saw grasshoppers and porpoise middle & latter part fine weather at daylight made all sail employed mending sails so ends this day Talt in 30th 26th Long in 49th 33rd W

Tuesday June the 26 this day comes in with fine weather all sail set at 4 PM went ashore top sail at sundown took in the light sails for the night middle & latter part fine weather all sail set repairing the fore top sail so ends this day

Wednesday June the 27 this day comes in with light winds all sails set at sundown took in the light sails for the night middle & latter part the same at 5 PM saw porpoise buccles lowered the mast boat with out success at 7 PM came on board & looked out for water to land on so ends this day Talt in 31st 30th Long in 49th 40th W
