Thursday June the 28 this day comes in with light winds all sail set employed taking out water at London took in sail for the night at daylight made all sail the first I heard was quarling I asked what was up and they could not tell so I sent them all aloft and John Silvia started and went in to rigging and said he would kill every damned Juniver Dick that put their hands on him or offered to I bled him down and bled the captain the captain went on deck and asked him what was the matter and John Silvia told the captain if he came any time where any time here I would split his brains or any toker man he says you dont now mee yet and the captain told the Juniver to get the drum gun and load it and then he threeds the gun on deck and went in to rigging and went aloft the captain bled him down but but he said he come down and when he got redy when we went down to breakfast he came down and went in to the fore cast fore castle after breakfast bled all barrels & they all come on deck but John Silvia the captain to him to come on deck he told him he would not come and he would put that rife in to the first man that offered to come down their one of the men started to go down to get the board that went in front of the ganway and he daved his rife & told him he would put it in to him then he throw his rife on the floor and came on deck the captain orderded me to put him in irons I put him irons and put him in to the run so ends this day John Silvia in Iron

Friday June the 29 this day comes in with light winds & calm all sail set three sails in night middle and latter part the same saw 3 sails so ends this day  
Falt in 32° 06' N  
Long in 46° 55' W

Saturday June the 30 this day comes in with fine weather all sail set employed painting at hill at 9 am took in sail for the night middle & latter part the same at 9 am saw 3 sails so ends this day  
Falt in 32° 14' N  
Long in 47° 08' W

Sunday July the 1 this day comes in with strong breezes from E heading at 1/2 middle & latter part strong gales from E & under double reefed top sail so ends this day  
Falt in 34° 47' N Long in 47° 29' W

Monday July the 2 this day comes in with strong gales from E & double reefed top sails & bores at 6 PM took in the fore top sail & main sail John Silvia in irons middle & latter part more made under double reef top sails so ends this day  
Falt in 35° 24' N Long in 47° 53' W

Tuesday July the 3 this day comes in with strong gales from E & under double reefed top sails middle & latter part the same employed painting the Bull works so ends this day  
Falt in 36° 26' N  
Long in 47° 19' W

Wednesday July the 4 this day comes in with strong breezes under double reef top sails middle & latter part fine weather at daylight made all sail employed painting the bul works so ends this day John Silvia still in irons and in the run  
Falt in 37° 08' N Long in 44° 52' W

Thursday July the 5 this day comes in with fine weather all sail set at 4 PM saw 2 sail middle & latter part the same all sail set employed painting so ends this day  
Falt in 37° 01' N  
Long in 46° 56' W
