

Remarks on Board Bark Lord B. Hall 1877

Monday Oct 8

this day begins with strong winds from the north north east with cloudy weather ship steering south east by east under double reef top sails and fore sail employed furling up spars and clearing the decks

Tuesday Oct 9

this day begins with strong winds from the north east ship steering east by south under top sails
Lat 24-47 N Long 55-28 W
employed furling a davit for the waist boat

Wednesday Oct 10

this day begins with strong winds from the north north east with clear weather ship steering east
Lat 24-43 N Long 55-23 W
employed breaking out for provisions and furling up spars

Thursday Oct 11

this day begins with light winds from the north north east with clear weather ship steering east by south under all sail
Lat 24-58 N Long 56-22 W
employed breaking out for provisions saw grampus

Friday Oct 12

this day begins with light winds from the north west with clear weather ship steering east by south under all sail
Lat 25-48 N Long 56-40 W
employed getting the rolling gear up nothing in sight to day

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Saturday Oct 13

this day begins with a hole side breeze from the south west with clear weather ship steering east south east under all sail
Lat 25-00 N Long 57-28 W
employed fitting the rigging sent down the main royal yard and sent up the hoops nothing in sight to day

Sunday Oct 14

this day begins with strong winds from the south west to the north west with clear weather ship steering east south east under all sail at 10 o'clock changing the course to east shortened sail at 10 o'clock and fled to the wind
Lat 24-46 N Long 58-11 W nothing in sight to day

Monday Oct 15

this day begins with a strong gale from the north west with clear weather ship steering east south east under close reefed top sails
Lat 25-04 N Long 40-17 W out ship in sight

Tuesday Oct 16

this day begins with strong winds from the north west with clear weather ship steering south east under main top distant sail
Lat 25-00 N Long 45-13 W
employed breaking out for water saw black bird to day
