

Remarks on Board Bark S B Hall

Wednesday Jan 16

This day begins with strong winds from the north, but with clear weather ship steering first south east under top sail and double reef fore.

Lat $33^{\circ} 20'$ Long $2^{\circ} 45'$ W
employed fitting the rigging nothing in sight to day

Thursday Jan 17

This day begins with light winds and calm at three o'clock P.M. bearing from the north west ship steering south east under all sail.

Lat $33^{\circ} 10'$ Long $1^{\circ} 36'$ W
employed in ad. work nothing in sight to day

Friday Jan 18

This day begins with a pleasant breeze from the north north west with pleasant weather ship steering south east under all sail at eight o'clock P.M. raised the pump merricks spoke her at seven o'clock A.M. noon. Stoom went aboard at one P.M. raised the bark the bird mate of that ship came aboard.

Lat $33^{\circ} 27'$ Long $1^{\circ} 17'$ miles W
took in the light sail at sun set ship steering by the wind he declined to the north east and eastward

Saturday Jan 19

This day begins with a pleasant breeze from the north north west with pleasant weather ship steering east south east at twelve o'clock he changed the course to south east.

Lat $32^{\circ} 55'$ Long $1^{\circ} 36'$ E
nothing in sight to day but one ship and a white water with down to day

This day begins with a pleasant breeze from the north north west with pleasant weather ship steering different courses under all sail.

Lat $33^{\circ} 10'$ Long $3^{\circ} 14'$ E
nothing in sight to day

Monday Jan 21

This day begins with a pleasant breeze from the north west with pleasant weather ship steering different courses to the north east and eastward under all sail.

Lat $33^{\circ} 05'$ Long $3^{\circ} 32'$ E
broke out water fitting the rigging etc nothing in sight to day

Tuesday Jan 22

This day begins with light winds and calm day pleasant ship steering south east by east under all sail.

Lat $32^{\circ} 47'$ S
broke out bread and flour for cooped all broke down and broke nothing in sight to day

Wednesday Jan 23

This day begins with a pleasant breeze from the north north west with pleasant weather ship steering different courses to the north east and eastward under all sail.

Lat $33^{\circ} 05'$ Long $5^{\circ} 30'$ E
employed fitting the rigging saw a small white water to day
