Friday Feb 8

This day begins with light south east trade winds with pleasant weather ship steering north north east under all sail
Lat $9^{\circ}42'$ Long $10^{\circ}27'$ E
employed fitting the rigging
nothing in sight to day

Saturday Feb 9

This day begins with light south east trade winds with pleasant weather ship steering north north east under all sail
Lat $11^{\circ}35'$ Long $10^{\circ}27'$ E
employed fitting the rigging
nothing in sight to day

Sunday Feb 10

This day begins with light easterly winds with pleasant weather ship steering north by east under all sail
Lat $10^{\circ}15'$ Long $10^{\circ}14'$ E
saw killdeer to day

Monday Feb 11

This day begins with pleasant south east trade winds with pleasant weather ship steering different courses to the north east and eastward under all sail
Lat $9^{\circ}50'$ Long $10^{\circ}56'$ E
employed paroling iron port and fitting the rigging broke out water and bread saw few birds to day

Tuesday Feb 12

This day begins with pleasant south east trade winds ship steering east north east under all sail. At twelve o'clock we changed the course to east
Lat $8^{\circ}10'$ Long $11^{\circ}35'$ E
employed paroling and fitting the rigging broke out boat bolt for light sail with saw grouper shot and killed one

Wednesday Feb 13

This day begins with pleasant south east trade winds with pleasant weather ship steering east under all sail
Lat $8^{\circ}45'$ Long $11^{\circ}44'$ E
employed fitting the rigging saw plank ship labored two boats struck one but lost him

Thursday Feb 14

This day begins with light winds and calm very pleasant day
not ship steering east under all sail at one o'clock P. M. changed the course to north
Lat $9^{\circ}00'$ Long $12^{\circ}17'$ E
employed fitting the rigging saw killdeer to day

Friday Feb 15

This day begins with light south east trade winds and pleasant weather very hot ship steering north under all sail
Lat $8^{\circ}34'$ Long $11^{\circ}37'$ E
employed fitting the rigging and paroling a little nothing in sight to day
