Thursday Mar 28

Lat 15-55 S Long 7-44 E
nothing in sight to day
were ship at sun set

Friday Mar 29

This day begins with strong
trade ship steering by the wind
heading to the eastward under
top sails at sun set were ship and
single reef the top sails

Lat 15-25 S Long 8-04 E
nothing in sight to day

Saturday Mar 30

This day begins with strong
trade ship steering by the wind
wind heading to the eastward
under top sails

Lat 15-35 S Long 8-55 E
broke out water to day
saw black fish

Sunday Mar 31

This day begins with a pleasant
breeze ship steering by the
wind heading to the eastward
under main top sail
Lat 15-35 S Long 9-00 E
saw two hawks to day

Monday Apr 1

This day begins with a pleasant
breeze ship steering by the wind
heading to the eastward under all
sails

Lat 15-19 S Long 9-29 E
fitting the rigging at four o'clock P.M.
saw the bark Ripper captain
Porter 18 months from home with 1000
specimen captain for his wife

Tuesday Apr 2

This day begins with light
wind ship steering west
under all sail

Lat 15-10 S Long 9-44 E
employed making masts of
oak to put aboard bark
saw Ripper in sight this morning

Wednesday Apr 3

This day begins with light wind
ship steering by the wind heading
to the westward under all sail

Lat 15-10 S Long 9-44 E
employed scrubbing the ship out
saw at four o'clock P.M. ship
the bark Bathurst captain Howland
30 months from home with 1000
also part the bark President

Thursday Apr 4

This day begins with a pleasant
breeze from the southward ship
steering west half south under
all sail

Lat 15-20 S Long 9-15 E
saw nothing in
sight
