

Remarks on Board Bark, S. B. Peale

Friday Apr 5

This day begins with light winds and calm ship stopping west half north under all sail. Lat $15^{\circ} 45'$ Long $100^{\circ} 44'$ employed setting up deck and rigging nothing in sight today

Saturday Apr 6

This day begins with light winds and calm ship stopping west by north under all sail. Lat $15^{\circ} 50'$ Long $100^{\circ} 55'$ employed worked out the water and began worked the masts moved the main royal yard nothing in sight today

Sunday Apr 7

This day begins with light winds and calm ship begins west by north half north under all sail. Lat $16^{\circ} 00'$ Long $101^{\circ} 05'$ saw grampies today

Monday Apr 8

This day begins with light winds and pleasant ship starting west by north half north at two o'clock anchored the vessel to west of north ship under all sail main and royal. Lat $16^{\circ} 00'$ Long $101^{\circ} 20'$ employed working the decks and fitting the rigging nothing in sight today

Tuesday Apr 9

This day begins with light winds ship starting at daylight west half north under all sail. Lat $16^{\circ} 00'$ Long $101^{\circ} 20'$ arrived the island of St Helena at six o'clock P.M. during night west by west half west about fifty miles of shore the bark sea ranged at two leagues and the galleon and Mary at six leagues

Lat $15^{\circ} 54'$ Long $101^{\circ} 33'$ W. at four P.M. at sunset left the wind on the starboard four yards ahead employed supplying the boat and ship got up cable and about six miles

Wednesday Apr 10

This day begins with light winds ship at daylight sailing with the head ahead about about two miles from land passing at daylight and up the town anchored in 18 fathoms of water with 50 fathoms of ground tackle went ashore at eight A.M. I did not get a ship letter employed working the ship and beating iron work getting ready for painting

Thursday Apr 11

This day begins with the ship in port employed painting out side rigging and rigging it up and about ten hundred pounds that ends this day
