Thursday April 25

this day begins with the ship in port employed painting the ship in side water a schooner on liberty

Friday Apr. 26

this day begins with the ship in port employed painting the ship in side and the davis

Saturday Apr. 27

this day begins with the ship in port employed painting and sending the sails over

Sunday Apr. 28

this day begins with the ship in port port water went as usual at one o'clock P. M.

Monday Apr. 29

this day begins with the ship in port nothing doing to day

Tuesday Apr. 30

this day begins with the ship in port. Six men shipped at this port came aboard at two o'clock P. M. had a short maple sail up and under way at five o'clock P. M. some ground the north end of the island of Oahu on the port tank ship heading south south west under all sail

Wednesday May 1

this day begins with a pleasant breeze ship steering by the wind heading to the southward under all sail

about 10-42 S. employed stowing the canvas broke out flaps and shipped down. One of the cargo tars, per fourth mate and five other men that was found in the ship after leaving port land in sight

Thursday May 2

this day begins with light pleasant weather ship steering by the wind heading to the southward and westward under all sail at two o'clock P. M. the ship heading to the north and east about 14-15 S. about 10-42 S. employed painting the bow boat and broke out water rose up new wheel rope nothing in sight to day

Friday May 3

this day begins with light pleasant weather ship steering by the wind heading to the eastward under all sail about 10-20 S. about 10-20 W. employed setting up the main rigging painting the bow boat per fifth mate in sight saw a school of black fish to day

Saturday May 4

this day begins with light pleasant weather ship steering by the wind heading to the eastward under all sail about 10-10 S. about 10-10 W. employed painting the rear bow boat and repairing the foremast black fish
