

Remarks on Board Bark S. B. Whale

Tuesday June 11

This day begins with the ship at anchor, lowered four boats, to search for humpback saw nothing from the boats saw two whales from the ship got aboard at 3 1/2 P.M.

Wednesday June 12

This day begins with the ship at anchor, lowered four boats, at half past five P.M. spotted a humpback saw two whales from the boats, chased them until five P.M. got aboard at six P.M. saw two more boats strike a whale

Thursday June 13

This day begins with the ship at anchor, lowered four boats, at half past five P.M. saw nothing from the boats, got aboard at five P.M. ship heeled over, got water and put the spare boat over board

Friday June 14

This day begins with the ship at anchor, lowered four boats, saw one whale to day, saw two whales from the ship, and saw the other two boats with one on the bottom, nothing more in sight to day

Saturday June 15

This day begins with the ship at anchor, lowered four boats, at half past five, saw nothing to day, got aboard at half past five P.M. saw one whale

Sunday June 16

This day begins with the ship at anchor, nothing doing to day, went ashore, got aboard at seven P.M. watched nothing a whale

Monday June 17

This day begins with the ship at anchor, lowered four boats, at daylight, saw nothing, got aboard at half past five P.M. saw one whale

Tuesday June 18

This day begins with the ship at anchor, lowered four boats, at daylight, chased two whales, shot one, got aboard at eight P.M. saw one whale, saw a steamship in sight

Wednesday June 19

This day begins with the ship at anchor, lowered four boats, at daylight, saw nothing to day, saw one whale at half past five

Thursday June 20

This day begins with the ship at anchor, lowered four boats, at daylight, saw nothing, saw one whale, ship got under way at twelve P.M. saw one whale, saw the land, approached at five P.M. in 11 fathoms of water with 30 fathoms of chain
