

## Remarks on Broad Br. h. S. B. S. H. A.

Monday July 1

This day begins with the ship  
at anchor. Several small boats out  
sight and the first one at  
last past ten o'clock takes a  
small group of about 30 people  
and back. It broke out soon.

Tuesday July 2

this day begins with the ship at anchor & landed four boats at daylight saw nothing by only the boats & did not proceed to day

Wednesday July 3

This play begins with the ship at anchor <sup>where</sup> your boats at daylight saw nothing to day

Thursday July 4

This day begins with the ship at anchor. Reached two boats at day light. Ship got under way at seven o'clock. Run down along the land anchored at four o'clock. In fifteen minutes of water with fifty fathoms of cable took out water boat and both saw two whales to sea.

Friday July 5

This day begins with the ship at anchor. However have bagged at daylight saw many whales to shoot tryed out to the harbor boat at 11.00 o'clock P.M. observed and struck the same again twice killed him and purchased and bagged two boats by him got the ship under way at eight o'clock P.M. and anchored at 11.00 o'clock P.M. Saturday morning observed of the whale in 18 fathoms or water.

Sunday July 7

This place begins with the split at  
Empire road two miles to west  
road for 6 miles through the about  
10 miles

Monday July 8

His day begins with the ship at anchor, towing three boats at daylight saw ten whales to day struck one from the starboard boat & about seven o'clock A.M. killed him and towed him to the ship, cut a long scalp at five o'clock P.M. & being time to day was a party.

Forrester July 9

this day begins with the ship at anchor. Hoisted three boats, sent four whalers to drag hailing and roting to day

Wednesday Oct 10

this day being with the ship at anchor  
lowered our boats at daylight saw several  
whales to day started at one
