

Remarks on Board Bark S.B. Hall

Thursday July 11

this day begins with the ship at anchor lowered four boats at daylight saw seven whales to day showing one from the foremast boat at two o'clock P.M. line parted early breakfast prepared to day broke out flowers boiling

Friday July 12

this day begins with the ship at anchor lowered four boats at daylight saw one whale started from the foremast boat at a signal at half past eight P.M. broke out water

Saturday July 13

this day begins with the ship at anchor lowered three boats at daylight saw two whales to day showing down oil to day

Sunday July 14

this begins with the ship at anchor not doing to day

Monday July 15

this day begins with the ship at anchor lowered four boats at daylight saw two whales to day broke out water deep and dark

Tuesday July 16

this day begins with the ship at anchor lowered four boats at daylight saw two whales to day

Wednesday July 17

this day begins with the ship at anchor lowered four boats at daylight saw nothing lowered the other three boats at eight P.M. ship got under way at eight P.M. anchored in eight fathoms at nine P.M. in ten fathoms of water with fifty fathoms of a haul net to sample the bark grayhound all night

Thursday July 18

this day begins with the ship at anchor lowered four boats at daylight saw two whales

Friday July 19

this day begins with the ship at anchor lowered four boats at daylight saw one whale along the land in company with the bark grayhound anchored in nine fathoms of water with fifty fathoms of a haul

Saturday July 20

this day begins with the ship at anchor got under way at seven P.M. ran along the land anchored at seven P.M. in the mouth of the Congo river in six fathoms of water part anchor with forty feet fathoms of a haul broke out water came out and ran with

Sunday July 21

this day begins with the ship at anchor got under way at seven P.M. ran to the northward and anchored at half past eight P.M. in four fathoms of water with fifty fathoms of a haul
