

Remarks on Board bark S. B. Hale.

Saturday August 3

This day begins with the ship at anchor
lowered four boats at daylight saw nothing
to day broke out water half and forth

Sunday August 4

This day begins with the ship at anchor
lowered three boats at daylight saw one whale
steering down oil broke out water
this is a mistake this is Mondays work

Monday August 5

This day begins with the ship at anchor
nothing doing to day but searching the
bottoms of the boats corrected from
above

Tuesday August 6

This day begins with the ship at anchor
lowered two boats at daylight ship got
under way at six o'clock then lowered
the third boat at two and a half lowered
the fourth boat for two whales struck
one to the right and one to the starboard
brought aboard two boats got aboard at
half past nine o'clock leaving two
boats one two each whale with night
ship anchored at seven o'clock in
thirteen fathoms of water with thirty
fathoms of shawl

Wednesday August 7

This day begins with the ship at anchor
got underway at four o'clock then stood
off shore anchored at eight o'clock in
fifteen fathoms of water got one whale
along side at four o'clock commenced
nothing got the second one along side
at four o'clock finished nothing at
seven P.M.

Thursday August 8

This day begins with the ship at
anchor lowered two boats at daylight
saw nothing explored nothing and nothing

Friday August 9

This day begins with the ship at
anchor lowered two boats at daylight
saw seven whales struck one to the
starboard boat line parted entailed
boiling

Saturday August 10

This day begins with the ship at anchor
lowered three boats at daylight saw one
whale finish boiling to day broke out
bottom

Sunday August 11

This day begins with the ship at anchor
nothing doing to day

Monday August 12

This day begins with the ship at
anchor lowered two boats at daylight
saw three now and half explored
steering down oil

Tuesday August 13

This day begins with the ship at
anchor lowered four and waist boats
at seven o'clock saw six whales to day
got under way at six A.M. ran along the
board to the northward anchored at five
P.M. in thirteen fathoms of water with
boats for bottoms of shawl broke out
water
