

## Remarks on Board Bark S. S. Hale

Wednesday August 14

this day begins with the ship at anchor. At daylight saw six or seven boats. Lowered two boats at half past six. At 8 AM saw nothing anchored at two PM in a boat twenty fathoms of water with forty five fathoms of sheet and lowered the other two boats (mistake)

Thursday August 15

this day begins with the ship at anchor. Lowered four boats at daylight saw nothing (corrected from above)

Friday August 16

this day begins with the ship at anchor. Lowered four boats at daylight saw five whales struck one to the starboard boat was dragged out with the bark grappled to day

Saturday August 17

this day begins with the ship at anchor. Lowered four boats at daylight saw a number of whales broke out beef

Sunday August 18

this day begins with the ship at anchor. Nothing doing to day

Monday August 19

this day begins with the ship at anchor. Lowered four boats at daylight saw a number of whales struck one to the starboard boat got him to the ship at seven PM broke out water

Tuesday August 20

this day begins with the ship at anchor. Lowered four boats at daylight saw a number of whales employed nothing broke out beef

Wednesday August 21

this day begins with the ship at anchor. Lowered four boats at daylight saw a number of whales struck one to the starboard boat got it along side at half past nine AM and put it in sent the laborers and went back away again. Tomorrow boiling

Thursday August 22

this day begins with the ship at anchor. Lowered two boats at daylight and the starboard boat at seven PM saw a number of whales employed boiling

Friday August 23

this day begins with the ship at anchor. Lowered four boats at daylight saw four whales struck most all day broke out beef and pork

Saturday August 24

this day begins with the ship at anchor. Lowered two boats at daylight saw a number of whales. Lowered the waste boat at four PM employed stowing down oil broke out flowers
