

Remarks on board bark S. B. Hale

Sunday August 25

this day begins with the ship at anchor nothing doing to day

Monday August 26

this day begins with the ship at anchor toward four boats at daylight saw a number of whales a crew aboard at eleven P.M. in the rain went off again at one P.M. went back gaining employed going out water and taking up sheets

Tuesday August 27

this day begins with the ship at anchor toward four boats at daylight saw a number of whales struck one for the appeared boat out the ship under way at eight and the stood in shore and anchored at nine P.M. in about fifteen fathoms of water with forty five fathoms of sheave took the whole along side and put him in not lines and sent three boats off at one P.M.

Wednesday August 28

this day begins with the ship at anchor toward four boats at daylight saw four whales saw the bark Grayhound boats fast to a whale

Thursday August 29

this day begins with the ship at anchor toward four boats at daylight saw a number of whales employed boiling

Friday August 30

this day begins with the ship at anchor got under way at five P.M. in company with the bark Grayhound reaching ship forward two boats at one P.M. anchored at seven P.M. in eighteen fathoms of water with forty five fathoms of sheave

Saturday August 31

this day begins with the ship at anchor got under way at five P.M. toward two boats at seven P.M. and the third boat at nine P.M. anchored at four P.M. in eleven fathoms of water with forty five fathoms of sheave in maymber day

Sunday Sept 1

this day begins with the ship at anchor nothing doing to day captain and mate ashore

Monday Sept 2

this day begins with the ship at anchor captain and mate ashore employed stowing down oil tank in the spare boat

Tuesday Sept 3

this day begins with the ship at anchor got under way at eight P.M. stood in shore anchored at two P.M. in eleven fathoms of water went up again at four P.M. employed putting the spare boat over board beating of the mast
