

Remarks on Board Bark S. B. Hale

Saturday sept 14

this day begins with light pleasant weather ship steering by the wind heading to the eastward under main top gulant sail were ship at three o'clock P.M. heading then to the west
Lat 4-34 S Long 10-36 E
employed bailing finished at four P.M.
saw one ship boiling and a small white water

Sunday sept 15

this day begins with light pleasant weather ship steering by the wind heading to the westward under all sail
Lat 5-05 S Long 10-50 E
nothing in sight to day

Monday sept 16

this day begins with strong breeze ship steering by the wind heading to the westward under all sail at six o'clock P.M. raised sperry whaler lowered four boats caught nothing came aboard at three o'clock P.M. at four lowered three boats on four feet ground
Lat 5-17 S Long 10-26 E
saw humpbacks and black fish broke out water

Tuesday sept 17

this day begins with light pleasant weather ship steering by the wind heading to the westward under all sail
Lat 5-17 S Long 10-26 E
employed stowing down sperry oil
saw one ship named after Dutch
saw President saw a carrier to day.

Wednesday sept 18

this day begins with light pleasant weather ship steering by the wind heading to the eastward at seven A.M. ran off before the wind steering different courses by the northward and eastward left to the wind at eleven A.M. on the port tank heading to the westward
Lat 5-30 S Long 11-01 E
employed mending the sail top sail and hoisting lines in the fore saw one sail

Thursday sept 19

this day begins with light pleasant weather ship steering by the wind heading to the westward under main top gulant sail were ship at one P.M. and saw again at three P.M. saw two ships spoke the bark Temperance
Lat 5-30 S Long 11-01 E
employed mending the four top gulant sail and hoisting new lines.

Friday sept 20

this day begins with light pleasant weather ship steering by the wind heading to the westward under all sail
Lat 5-30 S Long 11-01 E
employed bending new fore sail and fore top sail
saw one ship and black fish captain very rich

Saturday sept 21

this day begins with light winds and calm ship heading to the westward under all sail at eleven A.M. wind backed to the westward were ship heading then to the northward
Lat 4-37 S Long 9-05 E
nothing doing to day and nothing in sight
