

Remarks on Board Bark S B Hale

Sunday Nov 3

this day begins with a pleasant breeze
ship steaming different courses to the eastward
under all sail

Lat 6-10 S Long 10-9 E
shortened sail and left to the wind
saw blackfish to day

Monday Nov 4

this day begins with a pleasant breeze
ship steaming by the wind heading to the
westward under all sail at seven P.M. the
capt. of steaming different courses
through the day to the north and east
Lat 8-39 S Long 10-55 E
employed scraping down the spare masts
flaming water hose out water saw blackfish
under white water at sunset shortened
sail and left to the wind on the port tack
heading to the westward

Tuesday Nov 5

this day begins with light pleasant weather
ship steaming by the wind heading to the
westward under all sail at twelve the bark ship
heading then to the southward and eastward
Lat 8-40 S Long 10-00 E
employed in oil globe cooper repairing masts
saw blackfish

Wednesday Nov 6

this day begins with a pleasant breeze
ship steaming different courses to the northward
and eastward under all sail
Lat 8-08 S Long 10-16 E
nothing doing and nothing in sight

Thursday Nov 7

this day begins with light weather with
rain squalls ship steaming different courses to
the north and east under all sail
Lat 6-55 S Long 11-09 E
at three P.M. raised land bearing north east about
thirty miles off to the wind at the port tack
heading to the westward took in the jib sail at
sunset nothing in sight of the whale head to day

Friday Nov 8

this day begins with light winds and calm
ship going round and round land in sight about
thirty miles off at seven P.M. got a breeze
ship steaming by the wind heading to the westward
under all sail

Lat 6-00 S Long 10-55 E
saw a whale at sunset saw a humpback to day

Saturday Nov 9

this day begins with a stiff breeze ship steaming
by the wind heading to the westward under all
sail

Lat 4-20 S Long 9-38 E
broke out flower beef and pork at six P.M.
took ship heading to the eastward
nothing in sight to day

Sunday Nov 10

this day begins with a stiff breeze
ship steaming by the wind heading to the
eastward under all sail

Lat 5-00 S Long 10-05 E
shortened sail at sunset nothing in sight to day

Monday Nov 11

this day begins with a pleasant breeze
ship steaming by the wind heading to the
southward and eastward under all sail

Lat 5-40 S Long 10-20 E
at one P.M. took ship heading then to
the westward nothing doing and nothing in sight
